1) Road Safety Awareness Programme

Road safety awareness program was organized to make people aware about the importance of Road Safety and how we can reduce the deaths/ injuries due to road accidents. It focuses on two aspects installation of road safety signboards for road users and engaging with school students for awareness generation. The main aim of this initiative is to sensitize the road users and school students regarding road safety and traffic rules. This will help in reducing road accidents.

2) Horticulture Awareness Programme

BRKP held an awareness programme for progressive orchardists with an aim to equip them with modern farming techniques. A large number of farmers attended the awareness programme.

3) Workshop/ Seminar for Awareness on Handicrafts

A craft awareness programme was organized to create awareness about different types of handicrafts in India. Expert artisans gave live demonstration of their skills to the audience.

4) KVIC Khadi Vocational Training Programme

Khadi or khaddar is hand spun and hand-woven cloth from India, Bangladesh and Pakistan mainly made out of cotton. The cloth is usually woven from cotton and may also include silk, or wool, which are all spun into yarn on a spinning wheel called a charkha. A course on khadi weaving was held in collaboration with Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC).

5) Power Loom Awareness Programme

A power loom is a loom powered by water, steam, or electricity rather than by hand. Power loom Industry is the major contributor to Indian Textile industry as 62% of the textiles production in India is done on power looms. A programme was held for power loom awareness where participants were given information on the working of power looms.

6) Earth Day / Tree Plantation Programme

Trees were planted on Earth Day. Plating of trees is important because:

- 1. Plants have a complete cycle of taking in Carbon DiOxide (CO2) and giving out Oxygen. Thus planting more trees would help in reducing the amount of CO2 that is present in the atmosphere.
- 2. The more number of trees are planted, the cleaner the air will get. Having enough oxygen and reduced CO2 would make the air clean and free from pollutants.
- 3. Plants also have the ability to naturally filter dirty water. Thus planting more trees would not only result in cleaner air, but it would also make the water clean too.
- 4. Temperature has been constantly fluctuating due to a decrease in the number of plants. Plants can maintain atmospheric temperatures. In hot regions, having more plants would help regulate the heat.
- 5. Trees and plants are home to many wild creatures. A lot of birds build their nests on trees. Plants support wildlife. Planting more trees would not only help humans but it will support the whole biodiversity.
- 6. Planting trees makes the environment immediately more beautiful. Trees help prevent soil erosion. They also absorb different pollutants and thus make the air-water and earth cleaner.

7. Stitching Programme

BRKP has organized a stitching & tailoring training programme for women with the objective to generate employment opportunities and supplement family incomes of the local women. There is one center being run in which 55 trainees are getting training. Organization has very efficient and qualified vocational instructors who are giving training to the beneficiaries.

8. Health Awareness Programme

In order to create a healthier society by popularizing preventive measures, BRKP organized awareness programs on various issues of health and hygiene. Doctors were present for health check-up of

beneficiaries in the Programme. Besides this, we educated the participants on the importance of maintaining a healthy environment and surroundings to prevent various diseases.

9. Mask and sanitizer distribution for COVID-19

The current corona virus (covid-19) outbreak continues to spread. With growing numbers of confirmed cases in West Bengal, Bamongram Resham Khadi Pratisthan decided to make people aware on how to stay safe through distribution of masks, soaps, and hand sanitizers. BRKP is also carrying out awareness campaigns about the importance of maintaining social distance.

10. Eye Check Up Programme

An eye exam involves a series of tests to evaluate one's vision and check for eye diseases. Free eye check-up was provided to community members in Bamongram under the eye check-up programme.

11. Educational Development Awareness Programme

An awareness programme was held to highlight the importance of education.

12. Skill Development Training Programme

BRKP has been running Cutting & Tailoring Training for young women and adolescents. There are 4 centers that are being run in which 110 trainees are getting training. Organization has very efficient and qualified vocational instructors who are giving training to the beneficiaries. Skill development training for women is being organized to make them self-reliant by initiating their own small business.

13. Water Arsenic Programme

Drinking water, sanitation & hygiene awareness programme was organized by the society. The main aim of the society is to provide pure and clean water. So the wells, tube wells & ponds were cleared with the help of the members of the society. The members of the society were made aware about the presence of arsenic in water that they use. Efforts were made to help the civic authorities in providing sanitation facilities to more and more people.

14. Atmanirbhar Bharat Awareness Programme

Our Society organized an Atmanirbhar Bharat Awareness programme for rural women, youth and self-help groups. The main aim of this programme was to tell the responsibilities to the members of the group of how they can become integrated members of the society and be ready to solve various problems. The members appreciated this program very much.

15. Economic Development Programme

Savings Awareness Generation for Rural Women

The rural women in Malda district were made aware about the importance of savings. They were also made aware about how they can open bank accounts and keep their savings for a secure future.

Silk Saree Making

BRKP also participates in Silk Saree making. The women beneficiaries are a part of this programme. Whatever earning is made from the Silk Saree making is distributed amongst the women beneficiaries. Silk Saree making helps the women in becoming self-sufficient.

Silk Yarn Spinning

BRKP also takes part in silk yarn spinning for silk saree making. The women beneficiaries are a part of this programme.

Kreta Suraksha Awareness Programme

Kreta Suraksha Awareness Programme is organized to make the consumers aware about various aspects related to commodities. They are made aware about what all factors they shall be careful about while selling and purchasing commodities.

Vocational Training of Youth

Vocational Training was provided to the youth in many districts in West Bengal so that they can earn a livelihood to sustain themselves and their families.

16. Micro Finance Programme

Bamongram Resham Khadi Pratisthan offers a sustainable Micro Finance Programme for BPL groups, women & other weaker sections through formation of SHGS. We provide training in different trade, organizational management, accounting & banking. We also provide information relating to good schemes & procedures. We help in opening bank accounts & teach about their operation. We also help in the preparation of viable bankable project report for SHGs & individual entrepreneurs. We also assist in conducting market study and in marketing of the products.

We formed SHGs in following Areas:-

- a) Cutting and Tailoring
- b) Weaving & Spinning
- c) Dairy
- d) Fishery
- e) Medicinal plant cultivation

17. Rural Development Programme

BRKP implemented the rural development programme for the betterment of community people with the help of non-government/government agencies and community participation. For this purpose, the trust conducted a lot of activities like awareness programme on various issues, technology development, and formation of self-help groups among women.

18. Social Welfare Development Programme

In West Bengal, there are many social problems that need to be addressed like child labour, female foeticide etc. For addressing the social problems, social welfare programme was organized in the Malda district in West Bengal.

19. Rural Women Create Surekha Awareness Programme

An awareness camp on women surekha awareness program was organized by Bamongram Resham Khadi Pratisthan in the district Malda, West Bengal. A number of guest speakers attended the programme and delivered their lecture about the women surekha, care & protection. This program is generally based for the benefit of women especially those who belong to the marginalized community and deprived segment of the society. The most important part of this event was that it was all women who initiated the program and participated in a huge number. More than 250 women attended the programme.

20. Cultural Development Programme

Our main aim is to promote humanity, brotherhood, peace and harmony amongst people through cultural development activities. The organization works to create an environment of communal harmony and national integration. During this 2021-22 financial year, the society organized several Cultural programmes including Independence Day Celebration, Republic Day Celebration, Cultural Shows, Performance of Folk Music and Dance, Holi Milan Samaroh, Id Milan Samaroh, Stage and Street Plays, and BRKP Annual Day Celebration. The organization also organized cultural programs to promote peace messages. The organization also organized cultural events amongst children and

adolescents. We also conducted awareness talks among students on the relevance and significance of different festivals of all religions.

21. Retail Training Programme

The Trust has been conducting Retailer Training course with own fund and providing training on various retail sectors. Keeping the importance of retail education in mind, BRKP Retailer Training Programme is held for young boys and girls. There is one center where 20 trainees are getting training.

22. Telecom Training Programme

BRKP implements the telecom training program for giving a platform and direction to the youngsters. The Telecom training program has reached out to more than 100 beneficiaries in less than a year. The ratio of women beneficiaries is more than seventy percent. BRKP believes that if we efficiently empower women then it could help more than half of the population of the needy people. The telecom training centre also helps the participants to find employment in various local organisations or to establish their own venture.

23. SHG Formation

During this year, the organisation promoted & formed 30 nos. Self Help Groups among the rural women and also conducted 4 days Orientation Training Programme for SHG Functionaries. The organisation is also networking with Banks and other financial institutions for getting loans and other services to the SHGs for promoting their skills and to start small scale businesses.
